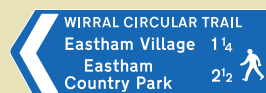
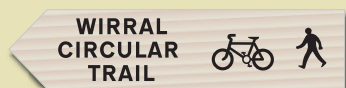


# Signage

## Countryside code

From a gentle stroll or relaxing picnic to a long-distance walk or heart-pumping adventure, the countryside provides every opportunity for enjoyment and relaxation.

- Be safe - plan ahead and follow any signs.
- Leave gates and property as you find them.
- Protect plants and animals, and take your litter home.
- Keep dogs under close control.
- Consider other people.

If you follow the Countryside Code wherever you go, you will get the best enjoyment possible and you will help to protect the countryside now and for future generations.

## Cycle safety

- Before each journey spend a few minutes ensuring that your bike is in good working order, paying particular attention to brakes, tyres and the steering system.
- Wear bright clothing and a cycle helmet. At night, front and rear lights and a red rear reflector are legally required, and get you seen.
- When riding on roads always follow the Highway Code.
