From an original idea to create a walking and cycling route around Wirral, funding was secured through the Rights of Way Improvement Plan from the European Regional Development Fund and the Local Transport Plan.



This guide will assist you to navigate along this 35 mile signposted trail, connecting up the public rights of way network with other routes around Wirral.

The trail starts and finishes at the Seacombe Ferry Terminal. You may wish to start the trail at any other point. The route description for each area is subdivided into sections containing anti-clockwise and the clockwise instructions, with useful information for that section.
